If the animal is returned within the first 24 hours you will receive a 100% refund, if the animal is returned after the first 24 hours but before the end of two weeks, you will receive a 50% refund. If you return the animal after the first two weeks, you will forfeit your adoption fee. Do you agree to this policy?
